- The Arab had contacts with India prior to their attack on Sindh
- They used to come for trade, particularly in the south-west coast of India
- with the growth of their military power their ambition also grow
- One cause of the attack of Arabs was their religious Zeal
- They also desired to extend their Empire
- They attracted towards Fabulous wealth of India

- A general of the Umayyad caliphate
- Invade the sindh region, defeated Dahir and captured Sindh region at the battle of Rawar
- Main reason of Invasion to avenge King Dahir for refusing to punish of Debol who plundered the Arab Ship

- King of Ghazni who ruled from 971 to 1030 Ad
- Ghazni for first time attacked modern Afghanistan and Pakistan in 1000 AD
- Ghazni invaded Bhatia in 1005 AD, Multan in 1006 AD and brought Punjab under Ghaznavids
- He was attracted to the enormous wealth of India, this made him repeatedly raid

- Also known as Muhammad Ghori, ascended the throne of Ghazni in 1173 Ad
- He first invaded India in 1175 Ad
- Mahummad Ghori was defeated by Prithviraj in the 1st battle of Tarain in 1191AD
- in 2nd battle of Tarain 1192 Prithiviraj defeated by Ghori
- Qutb-ud-din Aibak was appointed as the commander by Ghori
- He was assassinated in 1206 Ad in Central Asia by Khokhars.
- He considered to be real founder of the Turkish Empire in India.
