Dihang River

Originates from Talakaveri located in the western Ghats.  
Kaveri is also known as Dakshin Ganga.  
It is the third largest river after Godavari and Krishna in south India.  
Total length is 805 km, drain into Bay of Bengal.  
River flowing through Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.

Originates from Mahadev hills, satpura range, Madhya Pradesh.  
Located to the south of Narmada river, total length 700km, which flows westward through  
the state of Maharashtra, Gujarat, and Madhya Pradesh before draining into Arabian sea.  
Kakrapar dam & Ukai dam is on Tapi river

Originates in the Aravalli Range of Rajasthan.  
Total length is 371 km, drain into Gulf of Khambhat.  
Flow through Rajasthan and Gujarata.

Originates from Sikkim at Himalayas.  
total length is 315 km , flow through Sikkim &  
Bengal & then Bangladesh then drain in Bay of Bengal  
It join Jamuna river at Fulchhari in Bangladesh.

Originates in eastern Tibet.  
Flow through the Mishmi hill to meet the siang at the  
head of Brahmaputra valley.  
In china it is known as Zayu River.

Originate from the Himalayas in Arunachal Pradesh close to the Sikkim border .  
total length is 380 km and met with Brahmaputra at Dihingmukh.  
The Mishmi hill are found along the upper course of the Dihang River.
